This year we are excited to welcome our **keynote speaker Hannah Cusworth**, a historian and former Head of History. Having trained to become a teacher in 2012, Hannah taught in a number of London state schools before leaving teaching to start a PhD in 2021. As Head of History, Hannah introduced a new curriculum that embraced empire and migration stories. She researches and teaches about Black British history and the history of the British Empire. She regularly contributes to teacher CPD, history podcasts and documentaries. In the last couple of years, Hannah has worked with organisations such as the BBC, National Portrait Gallery and Chelsea Physic Garden.

Neil has been teaching in Hampshire 'since just after the end of the Cold War'. He has been a Head of Department and a long-time member of the Hampshire Steering Group. Neil was co-author on the Making Sense of History textbook series and has run well-received workshops at SHP and HA Conferences.
