With keynote speaker: Glenn Carter

Glenn is a Year 5 teacher from the Northeast who is passionate about leading and teaching history. He is an Associate Specialist Adviser for Primary History at Education Durham, a member of the Historical Association's Primary Committee, and owns and runs the website [History Rocks](#). Glenn has worked with a number of educational providers nationally and internationally to promote coherence, knowledge and passion in history for primary schools.

Glenn will be speaking about **creativity and connection in history** – how we can engage students in a meaningful way that allows them to remember more, as well as seeing how different parts of history are all connected together, rather than studying single, isolated units.

A diverse range of workshops will provide practical opportunities spanning EYFS, KS1 and KS2 for history subject leaders to:

- Network with colleagues.
- Enhance their subject knowledge.
- Keep abreast of national and local developments.
- Gain confidence to lead and manage primary history.
- Get up to date with Ofsted expectations for primary history.
- Be better able to select literature to support teaching of history.
- Explore ways of raising standards of teaching and learning in history.
- Explore engaging teaching approaches and best practice in primary history.
- Grow in their expertise to inspire colleagues to teach high quality history in their schools.
- Look at how to demonstrate intention, implementation and impact in relation to the history curriculum.
